- 1) Registration is mandatory.

- 4) The maximum duration of time shall be 60 seconds.
- 5) Reels file can be in MP4 format and the video should be made vertically and NOT horizontally.
- 6) The resolution must be 1080p HD pixels for the sake of clarity and precise judgment.
- 7) Reels must be original, inspired by existing trends online, and free from copyright issues.
- 8) Reels should be in English and Hindi both and should not contain offensive, name-calling, derogatory remark, or regional slang.
- 9) Participant shall grant the organizers the non-exclusive right to screen their reels on their websites social media, and other screenings.
- 10) Reels can be submitted ONLY to this email.nc.gcondurg@gmail.com before 25/2/25 time 5pm.
